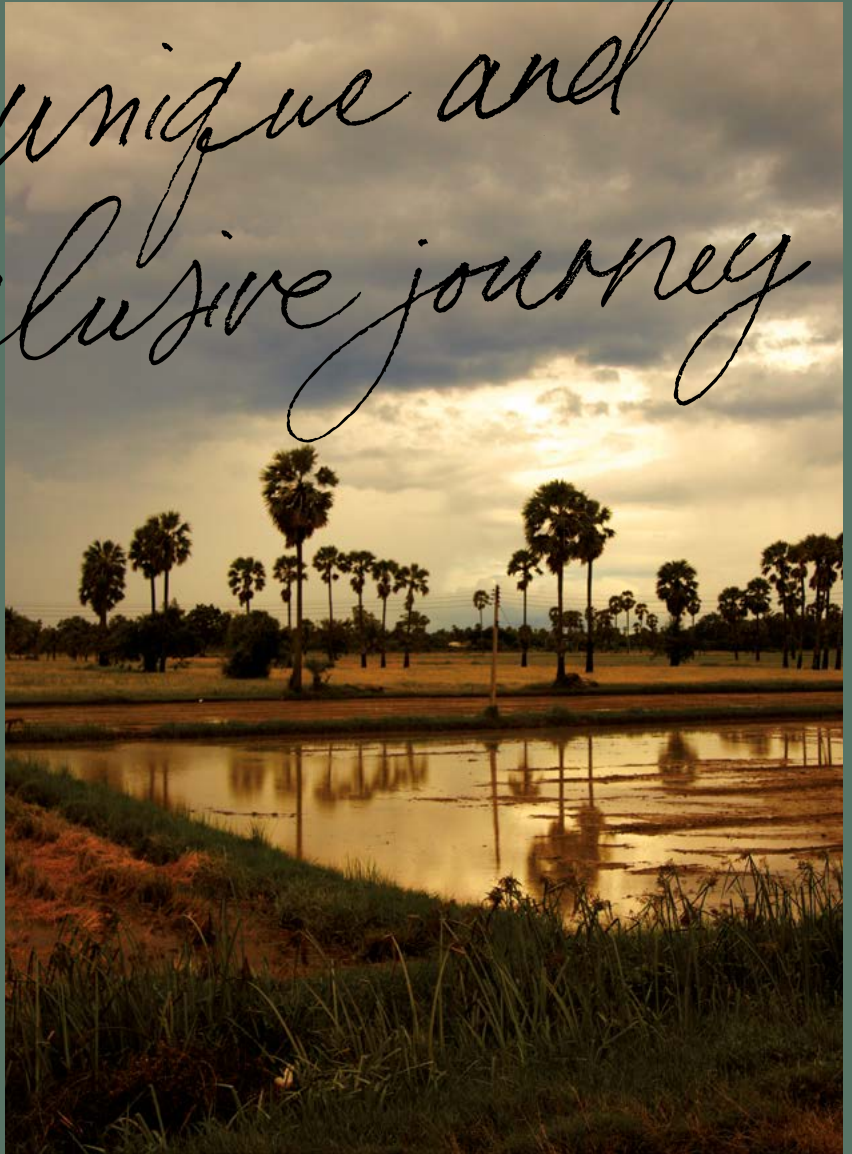

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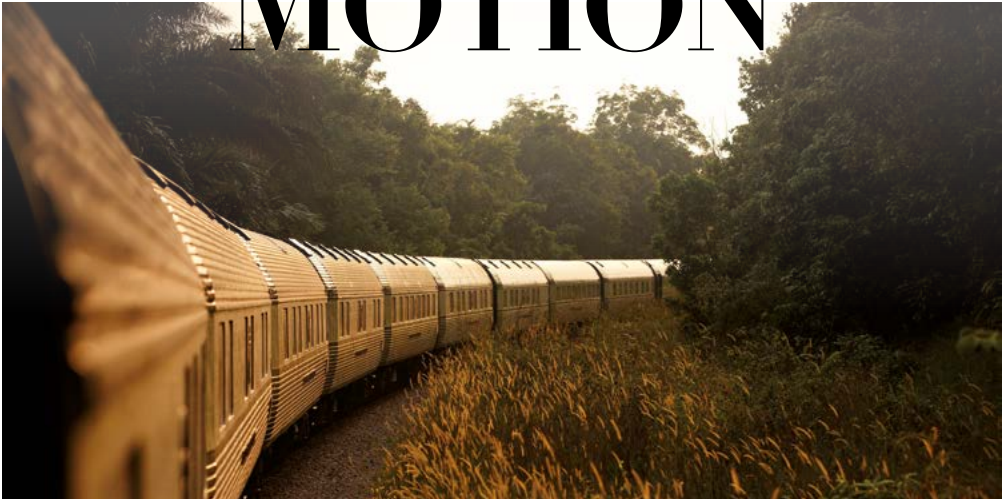

Day 1 (Singapore to Gemas)

MONDAY

12 MAY

Board the striking green and cream carriages of the Eastern & Oriental Express at Woodlands Station, Singapore. Settle into your newly restyled cabin, a sanctuary of cherrywood paneling, Thai silks and Malaysian embroidery. As the train travels through the wild, green landscapes of Malaysia, it sets the scene for your immersion in nature. Weave through tangled jungle, rubber and palm plantations, soaking up the vistas as your steward serves an afternoon tea in your cabin. Soon, evening falls and it's time to dress for dinner in the Restaurant Car. Indulge in a feast whilst enjoying engaging onboard entertainment with your nightcap.

Day 2 (Taman Negara)

TUESDAY

13 MAY

Arrive in the early hours into Merapoh station this morning. After breakfast alight for a choice of four extraordinary excursions.

Taman Negara National Park was formed 130 million years ago, making it one of the oldest tropical rainforests in the world. The dense jungle, wide rivers and lush mountains are home to incredible wildlife including water buffalo, macaques, tapirs, hornbills and the elusive Malaysian tiger. Venture into the forest to discover the home of the Malayan tiger and the efforts to safeguard its future, join a nature photographer and conservationist for a wild and wonderful immersion, or discover the otherworldly allure of the rainforest's magnificent caves. Additionally select and enjoy a sublime wellness experience in the heart of this tropical paradise. Meet local villagers and gain a wealth of insight from dedicated experts before returning to the train for lunch.

During lunch and the afternoon, soak up the vistas as the train travels on the jungle line past rice paddies, palm trees and rural Malaysian villages.

Day 3 (West-Coast Line to Penang)

WEDNESDAY

14 MAY

Enjoy breakfast and lunch on board, before alighting for the transfer to either the iconic `Cheong Fatt Tze` – (The Blue Mansion) building or the legendary `E & O` hotel. Both stunning and historic buildings are in the heart of George Town with its UNESCO Heritage status.

At the Blue Mansion you will have the opportunity to meet the current owner and conservator for a personal insight into the buildings history and a chance to experience a traditional Malaysian Indigo Batik display and an actual demonstration into the delicate process of creating and applying these unique designs to fabrics. Additionally, be entertained by a classic Guzheng performance whilst enjoying a typical Malaysian Nyona afternoon tea and even a chance to watch and learn to play a traditional Mahjong demonstration.

The legendary `E&O` hotel built in 1885 by the Sarkies Brothers who went on 3 years later to build Raffles in Singapore. This visit will provide an opportunity to view some of the stunning images from the `Eye on the Tiger` photographic exhibition from London's Royal Albert Hall and an opportunity to meet the curator. Additionally, you will have a unique opportunity to view or take part in a wonderful creative workshop with one of Malaysia's leading wildlife artists.

Complete your visit with a traditional classic English afternoon tea, overlooking the Andaman Sea.

Return to the train by private car transfer for your last night with a special dinner and entertainment.

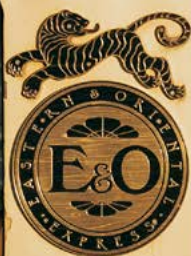
